**NHS England Update**

Announcement of Primary Care Reforms

NHS England have announced the first dental contract reforms for 16 years with a focus on delivering care to high needs patients and making it easier for patients to access NHS care. There has been an acknowledgement that under the current banding system, some treatments are not sufficiently remunerated. There will therefore be a change to the number of UDAs awarded for some Band 2 care - for example, molar endodontic treatment (on permanent teeth) will, in future, attract 7 UDAs rather than 3 UDAs. It is anticipated that these proposals will be accepted through the parliamentary process in Autumn and come into operation in due course.
