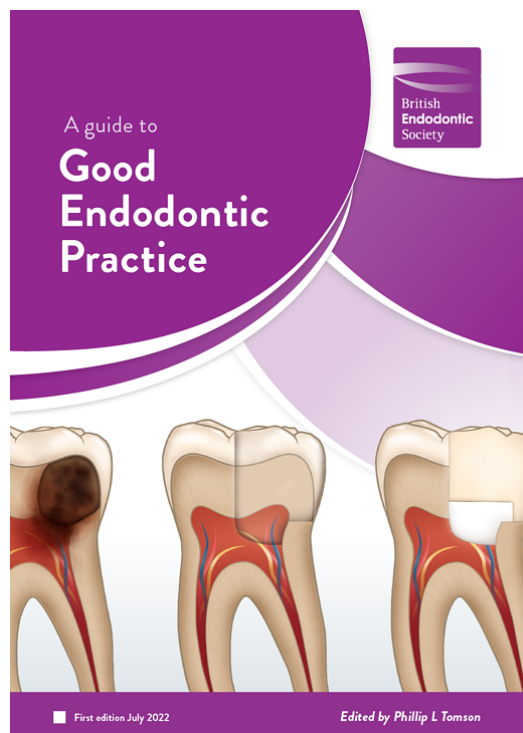
## **A Guide to Good Endodontic Practice**
